**Notice of Race**

Organizing Authority: Hull Yacht Club in conjunction with the International 110 Class Association.

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS). The Bylaws, Rules Committee Rulings, and the Championship Regulations of the International 110 Class Association shall apply.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International 110 Class. Skippers shall be active full members of the International 110 Class Association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form in its entirety and submitting it, along with the entry fee, to the Championship Committee by 1200 hours on Monday, September 16, 2024. Entries may be made in advance by mailing the entry form and payment to:

- 2.3 On-site registration will be held in the porch area of the Hull Yacht Club. To complete registration a representative of each boat shall check-in at this location and both skipper and crew will be required to sign a liability release and assumption of risk agreement.

**3 FEES**

The registration form and entry fee shall be \$250 if postmarked on or before August 15, 2024. A late fee of \$50 shall apply to all entries postmarked after this date. Checks should be made out to: **Thomas E Craig** and marked 110 Nationals 2024.

- 4.4 Seven races are scheduled.
- 4.5 One extra race per day may be sailed, provided that the regatta does not become more than one race ahead of schedule.

## **5 MEASUREMENT**

- 5.1 Each boat entered in the regatta shall have, or receive at the time of measurement, a valid measurement certificate.
- 5.2 Safety equipment inspection and weighing shall take place at the Hull Yacht Club.
- 5.3 All boats should have a hoist-lift-type lifting bridle or straps.
- 5.4 Any necessary hull, spar, and foil measurements must be coordinated in advance with the regatta measurer.
- 5.5 All sails used in completion must be measured and approved by an official class measurer. Measurement of new or modified sails is available at the Hull Yacht Club on Monday, September 16 between 0900 and 1200 in the ballroom.
- 5.6 A safety equipment inspection and may be conducted by the race committee before and at any time during the regatta.

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available on the Class website and Facebook page. Printed sailing instructions will be available at on-site registration.

## **7 VENUE**

Racing will take place on sweet Hull Bay.

## **8 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward type courses, and a Gold Cup course in compliance with the International 110 Class Championship Regulations.

## **9 SCORING**

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 When fewer than seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **10 BERTHING**

The regatta is to be wet sailed. Moorings will be provided.

## **11 LAUNCH AND HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

- 11.1 All boats shall be afloat before 1800 on Monday, September 16. Exceptions to this rule must be approved in advance and in writing by the chair of the boat management committee or their designee.
- 11.2 The Hull Yacht Club hoist is tide dependent and a 110 can only be launched or hauled 3 hours before or after high tide
- 11.2 Once afloat, boats shall not be hauled out prior to the completion of the last race of the regatta, unless repairs are required. Any such repairs shall be approved in advance, and in writing by the PRO, and take place under the conditions set at that time.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 12.1 Competitors should monitor VHF channel 68 for on-the-water communication with the race committee.
- 12.2 Except in an emergency, or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded for the top three overall competitor teams

## **14 WAIVER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for property loss or damage, or personal injury or death, sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
